Dear Friends,

Thank you for considering a donation to our fundraiser, the **Rock2Cure DIPG Benefit Concert + Auction**, taking place on **Saturday, June 13, 2026**, at **The Barn @ Wilson Farm**. We are currently seeking both monetary donations and auction items for our silent auction and would be incredibly grateful for your support.

On December 22, 2015, our son Camron was diagnosed with **Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG)**—a rare and aggressive pediatric brain tumor that affects approximately 300 children each year. Located in the brainstem, DIPG is extremely difficult to treat, and there is currently no cure.

Camron was a 15-year-old sophomore and lacrosse player at Bonney Lake High School when he was diagnosed. He was quick-witted, full of life, and had a smile that could light up any room. Alongside our older son, Jordan, we fought tirelessly for Camron during his 27-month battle. Throughout that time, we were uplifted by the incredible support of our friends, family, and community.

On March 10, 2018—his 18th birthday—Camron passed away, surrounded by love. Later that year, we established the **Team Cozzi Foundation** in his honor, continuing the fight for a cure—just as Camron wished.

Proceeds from this event will support vital research efforts, fund clinical trials, and aid families currently facing a DIPG diagnosis. Through our partnership with **DDRFA.org**, we have been able to contribute funding to researchers around the world, helping move us closer to better treatments and, ultimately, a cure.
